HUSBAND - "William" Friedrich Wilhelm Ludwig Heppenheimer

Extract from the Birth Register of the Evangelical Parish of Stockstadt am Rhein

"In the year of Christ eighteen hundred and thirty three, on May twenty seventh around 1 AM, according to a credible report, the second child and second son of this marriage, was born to

the local burgher and flour merchant Johann Friedrich Heppenheimer and to his third wife Eleonore Dorothea Elisabeth née Hornung. He was baptized June ninth and received the names Friedrich Wilhelm Ludwig. Godparents were: Dr. Wilhelm Hamann from Gießen; Louise Hornung, legitimate and single daughter of the late pastor Heinrich Philipp Hornung from Dietzenbach; and the local burgher and lumber-merchant Friedrich Wilhelm Kast, who undersigned this record together with the father, and with me, the pastor who performed this baptism." sign. Friedrich Heppenheimer; sign. L.G. W. Alsfeld, Pastor; sign. Friedrich Wilhelm Kast

A Wm Heppenheimer, printer, was naturalized in 1851. His address is given as 22 William Street.

1860 census finds him living in NYC with Fred. He was a printer and later moved to Jersey City, working with F. Heppenheimer, Litho.

Information from family sources show that he was the half-brother of Frederick Heppenheimer, the lithographer.

1870 census finds Wm living in Jersey City Heights with a Catherina and their children, Annie and Wm 1900 census has him living with wife (Martha?) and all 5 children.

Per 1900 census, he arrived in America in 1865, but this is not consistent with other data..

Per 1910 census, he is retired and living with a son-in-law, Charles Wolken (German).who had been in this country since 1886.

Jersey City Directory from 1889-1893 finds him (lithographer) and his son (clerk) living at 345 St Paul's Ave.

He was from Stockstadt, Hesse-Darmstadt. Correspondence with Jeorg Hartung provided a Family Register from his Familienbuch for Stockstadt that shows a Friedrich Wilhelm Ludwig Heppenheimer, born May 27, 1833, to Johann Friedrich Heppenheimer and Eleonora Dorothea Elisabetha Hornung (married Sept 9, 1829 in Stockstadt).

#### WIFE - Catherina (Martha) Boller

Per the 1880 census, she was confined.

### CHILD 1 - William Heppenheimer Jr

Per the 1880 census, he is working in the art jewelry trade.

Per 1900 census, he is living with his father and family, and working as a brakeman

### CHILD 2 - Anna Catherine Heppenheimer

She is living with her husband and w/o children in Jersey City in 1910, 1920 and 1930

### CHILD 3 - John Heppenheimer

1900 census shows he is working as an actor.

#### CHILD 4 - Christiana Heppenheimer

In 1910, she is living with her father and the Wolkens and working as a book keeper for an insurance company.

#### CHILD 5 - Emil Heppenheimer

In 1910, he is living in Newark, not with his parents, and working as a bartender.

#### CHILD 6 - Albert Heppenheimer

Died young

#### CHILD 7 - NN Heppenheimer

Birth per Jersey City Birth Index for 1879-1880. Died young
